We have had numerous small donations including hirings for the Theatre and Clubroom, £25.00 from The Woodvale Readers, Calendar Sales and a small donation from St. Faith's Church for our share of the takings in the Christmas Tree Display. These, with our monthly income from the Ice Cream shop and Bar Takings means that our income has exceeded our outgoings this month.

We have now sold 269 calendars to date and will have £1,365.00 to donate to Leukaemia & Lymphoma Research - we hope to have a presentation with a large cheque for the occasion.

We made £293.05 On-Line from "Snowed Under" so they made at least that to donate to Charity and we also did very well on the bar.

The next money making occasion is the Spring Fayre which is to be on the 23rd March from 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. Again I would ask everyone to help by making cakes, donating books, bric-a-brac, plants, raffle or tombola prizes.
