





TREASURER'S REPORT



Balances:

Current Account	£3,876.12 credit
Deposit Account	£28,823.70 credit

Although there is a sad face this month, mainly because we had to pay some large bills, we have some really good news - we did nearly as well as last year for the Spring Fayre in spite of the awful weather on the day. Last year we made £606.85 and this year it was £590.75 - only £16.10 difference!

We have made £150.00 profit over the year on various Social Events, we have had sponsorship of £100.00 for the programme, we've hired out the Clubroom and finally we raised £292.50 for the Young Carers at the Charity Quiz this week-end, though that will go out again.

All the big bills have now been paid and we have "Return to the Forbidden Planet" in a couple of weeks followed by the two One-Act Plays "Witches of Prestwick" and "Happy Birthday Me" in May, so they should improve the state of the coffers.
