



PRESIDENT'S REPORT MARCH 2020

"Wife After Death" has been postponed, hopefully reappearing early September, and "Bugsy Malone" also postponed, again hopefully reappearing in mid October. It remains to be seen whether "The Shadow Factory" finds space in what will be a very tight programme when we re-open. Unfortunately, Coffee mornings in April, (there wasn't one scheduled for May) and June are all currently cancelled. The Community Quiz has had to move to next year. The first aid training from the Ambulance Service has been cancelled but hopefully can be rescheduled in 2021. That I hope, for the time being is the bad news.

Now for the good news. Your committee is looking forward to the theatre reopening hopefully at the end of the summer/early autumn. With that in mind we are currently planning the showings of "Wife After Death" and "Bugsy Malone" and then the production of the panto. We had planned to hold our AGM on June 1 which has now had to be postponed and will happen later in the year once we are active and have time to give notice. Going on information currently available, it will be some time before we can gather again, but we do hope that everyone will pull together to get us up and running as we have lost financially quite considerably and need to show the public that we are alive and kicking!!!

As a not for profit organisation Trinity Theatre has been delivering high quality entertainment for over 77 years and we rely on the income from our box office and outside hirings and now, in light of our desperate need for a new roof, audience donations to survive. We have had a survey of the building carried out, just awaiting the written report, to enable us to go ahead and apply for grants but we will also need to prove that our members and local public are supporting us.

Before closing, I would like to thank Cheryl, our Stage Whisper Editor for the last couple of years, for all the hard work she has put into the production of our newsletter. Luke and Brie Mulhern will be taking over from the next issue.


